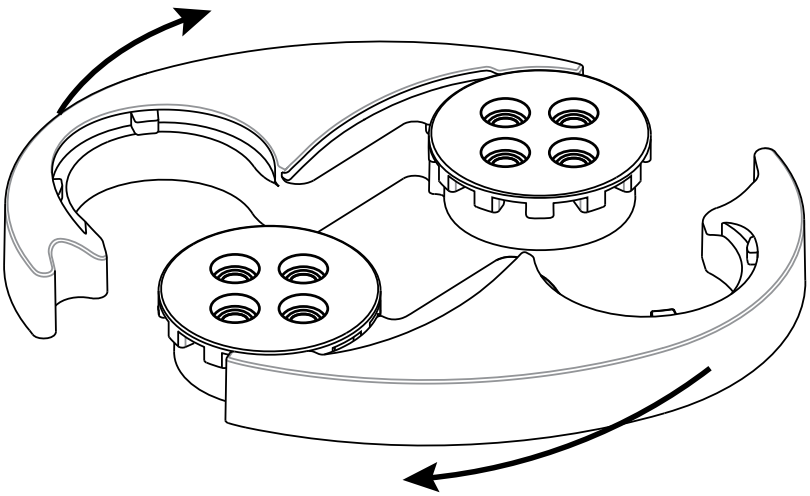

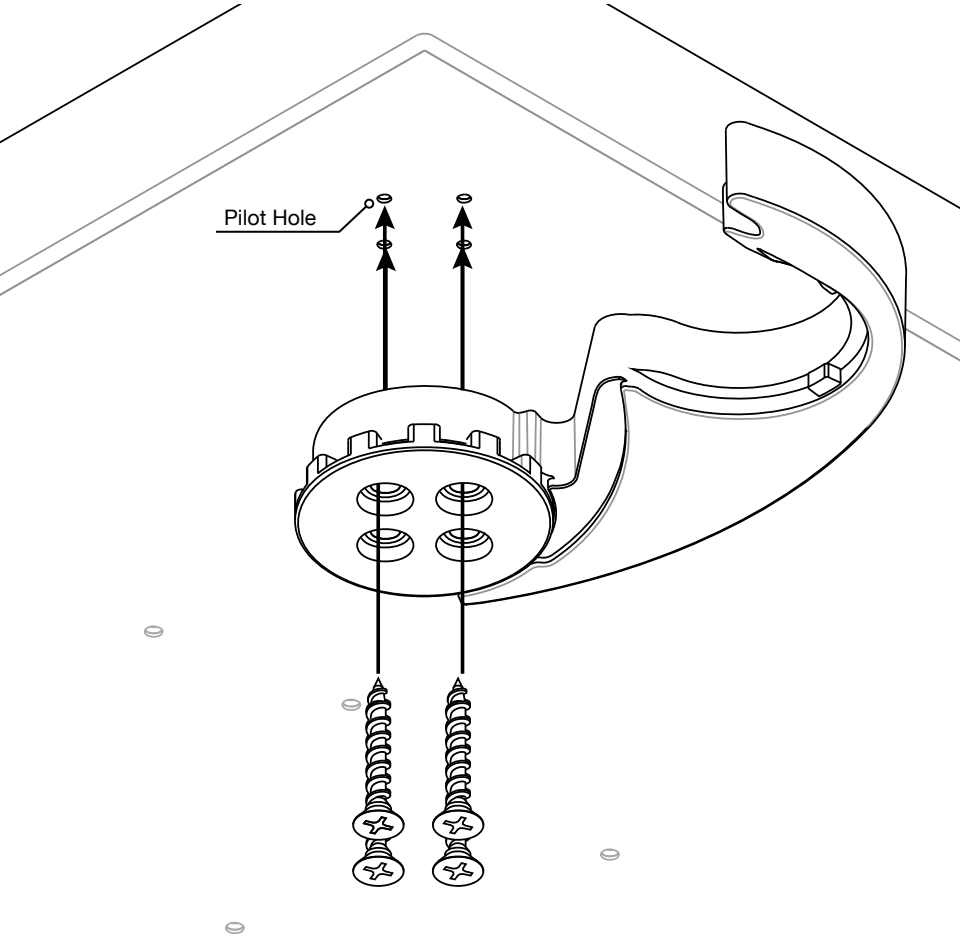
- Ganging Bracket (2)
- M4 x 30 mm Screw (8)



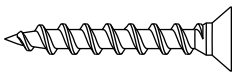
Step 1: Open the ganging bracket and separate it into its two pieces.



Step 2: Attach one half of the ganging bracket to the underside of the table and the other half to the table you're ganging the first table to.

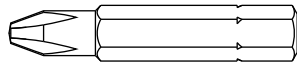

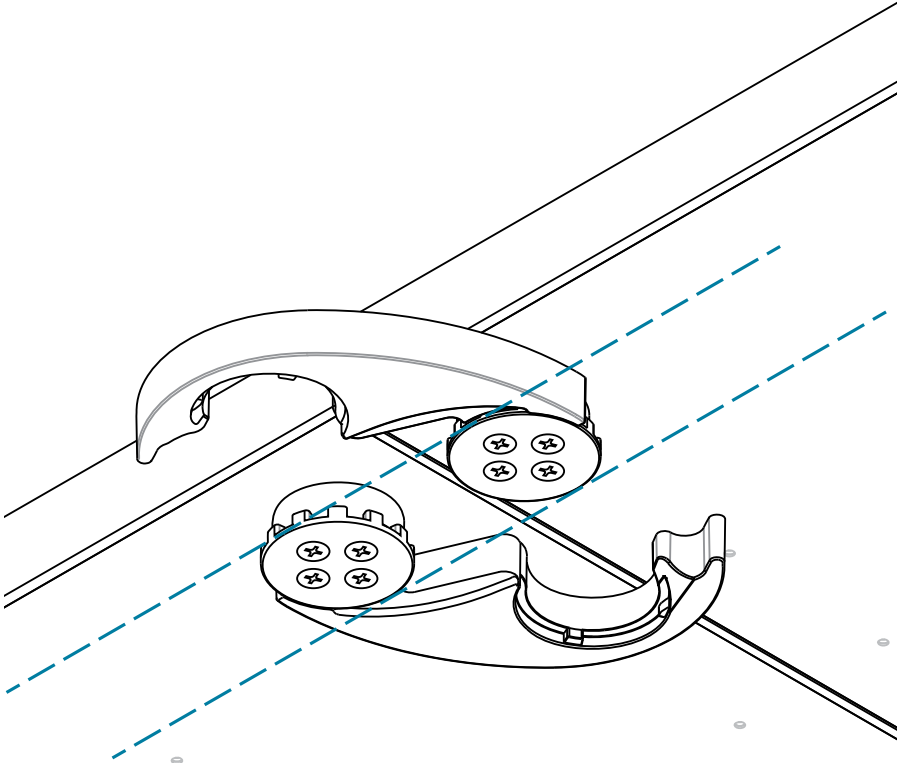

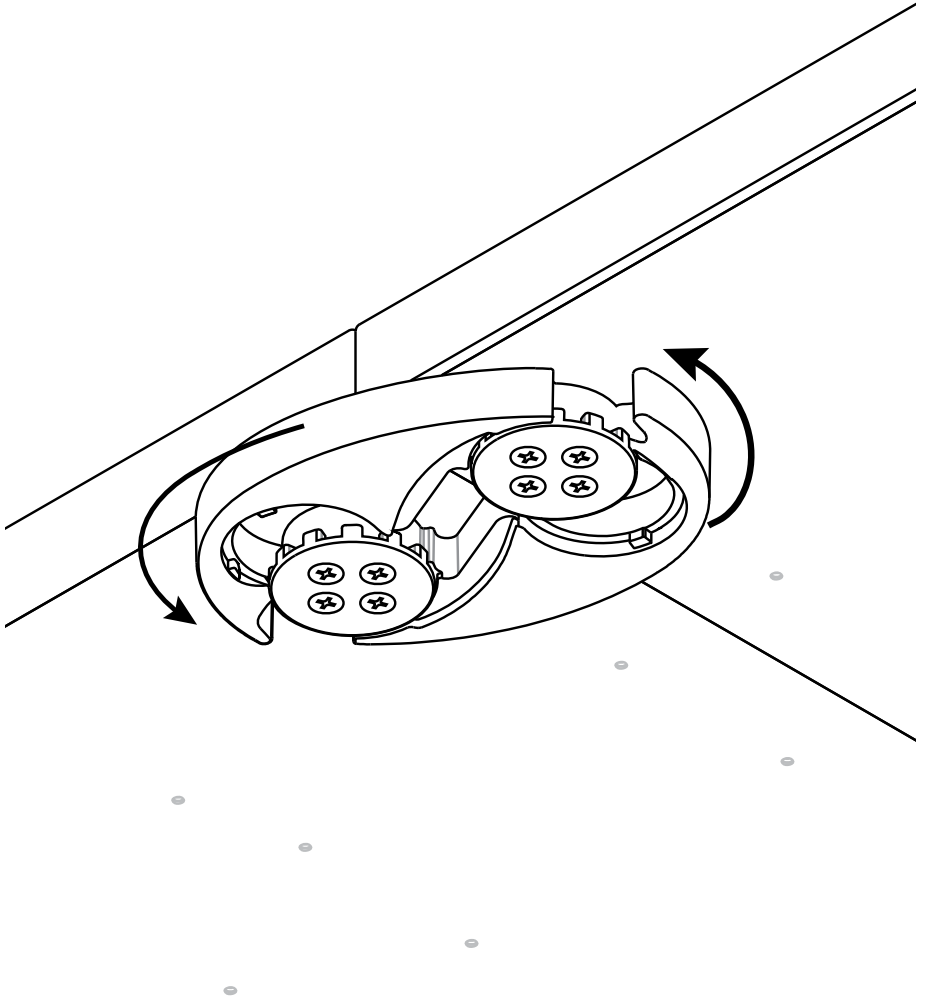


#2 Phillips Bit

Step 4: Close the ganging brackets.

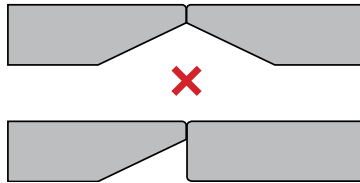

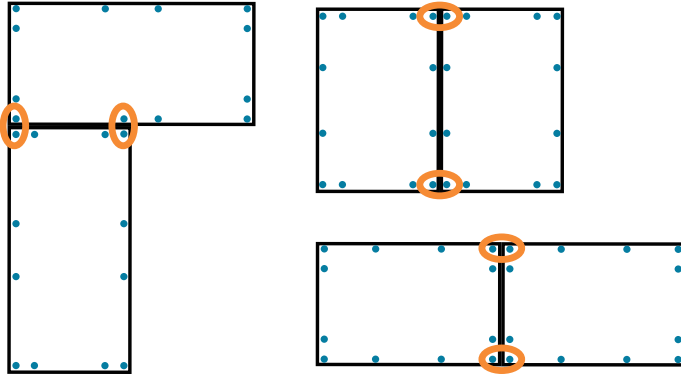

Knife-edged rectangular tabletops on a C-Leg base can only gang back-to-back if the tabletop has a depth of 30".

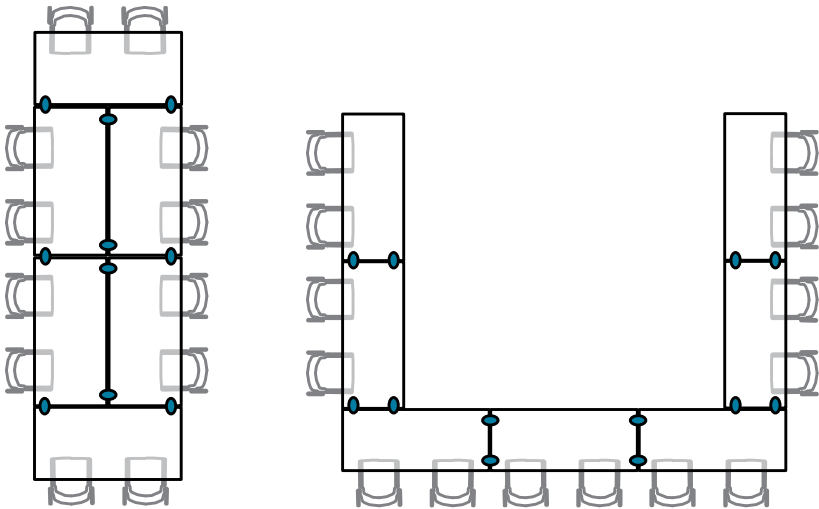


The number of ganging bracket attachment points varies because tables cannot gang together on a knife edged side.

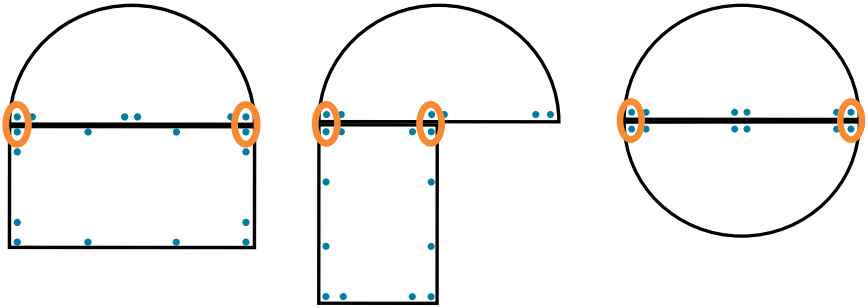
Attachment Points



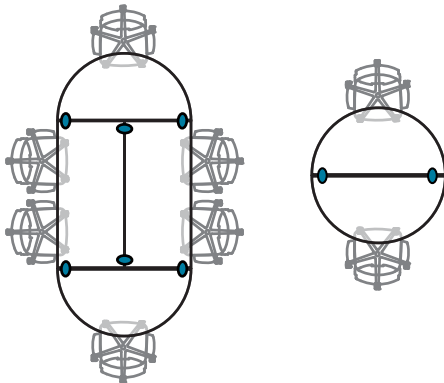
Sample Layout With Rectangles



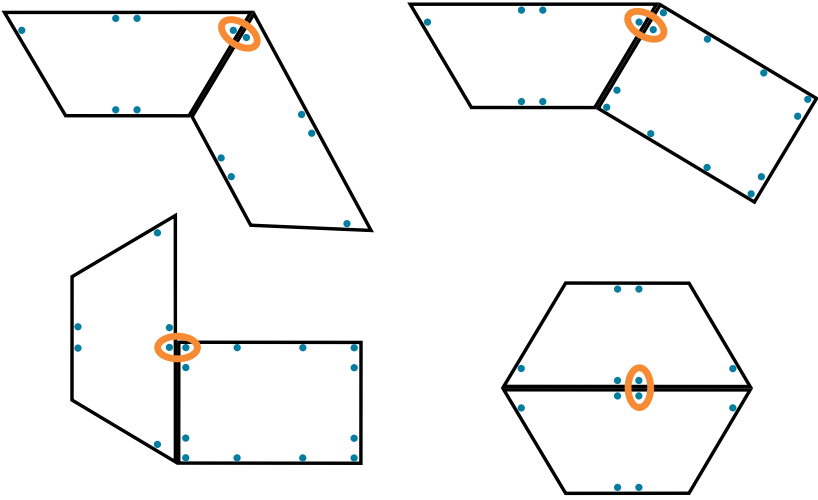
